Jobs with Justice affiliation is available to membership organizations who support the basic principles of Job With Justice, encourage their members to sign the Jobs With Justice Pledge to come out 5 times a year to support someone else's struggle, and mobilize their members to support Jobs With Justice Actions. The Central Florida Jobs With Justice Organizing Committee is working to support the building and strengthening of local Jobs With Justice coalitions in Central Florida. Jobs With Justice stands for the protection and extension of the rights of working people and their communities including:

- The right to a decent standard of living.
- The right to organize and bargain collectively.
- The creation of family supporting jobs.

Annual Dues

- \$1,000 per year level
 - International unions, national organizations or denominations, or organizations.
- \$750 per year level
 - Regional entities of national unions, denominations or organizations.
- \$500 per year level
 - Local unions, community organizations or denominations with over 5,000 members and annual budgets of over \$250,000.
- \$250 per year level
 - Local unions with membership between 501 and 5,000 members and annual budgets under \$250,000.
 - Community organizations and denominations with membership between 2,000 and 4,999 and annual budget over \$150,000.
- \$100 per year level
 - Local unions with fewer than 500 members.
 - Community organizations and denominations with membership between 501 and 2,000 members and annual budget under \$150,000.
- \$50 per year level
 - Minority, religious and community groups with membership under 500 or an annual budget under \$5,000.
- \$25 per year level
 - Individuals.
